Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you are all keeping well and safe at this time.

You will be aware from the news that the Government has announced primary schools will not be open to all pupils for the last month of the summer term, which they had previously stated was their ambition. They recognise it is simply not possible to teach all pupils in groups rather than full classes; there are not enough classrooms or staff available in any school to achieve this.

At the moment we are reintroducing Reception and Year 1 children to school, in addition to the places we have offered to vulnerable and key worker children, following previous Government directives. We will now look carefully at how many extra places we can offer to pupils across the school and will discuss the criteria for allocating them with the school's governors. Please be assured that if it is at all possible to offer your child a place before the end of the academic year we will do so, however please also remember that full time places for all pupils cannot be provided at this time. I will keep you informed about our plans as they develop.
