Autumn 2 Curriculum Coverage

<p>English - In English this term we will be working on our core book, <i>Somebody Swallowed Stanley</i>. I can identify rhyming words and write my own couplet of an animal. I can talk about the difference between fiction and nonfiction. I can identify the features of a chronological report. I can write a chronological report of a Whale. I can write a food diary for a Seagull. I know the format of an instructional piece of writing. I can complete an instructional piece of writing to make a kite. I can plan, draft, edit and publish a persuasive piece of writing by making a poster.</p>	<p>Maths - In Maths this term we will be working on our subtraction, shape and number knowledge. I can subtract within 10 using manipulatives, part part whole model and a numberline. I can compare addition and subtraction facts and find the 8 fact families. I can name, identify the properties and sort 2D shapes. I can name, identify the properties and sort 3D shapes. I can count forwards and backwards from any number within 20. I can read and write numbers as words to twenty. I understand what tens and ones are. I can find one more and one less in teen numbers. I can order numbers.</p>

We will explore all objects and what materials they are made of. We will learn how to describe materials by looking at their different properties and discuss how materials can have more than one property. We will be able to distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made. Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock. Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.</p>
